

Green-veined white	<i>Pieris napi</i>	Not that common
Small white	<i>Pieris rapae</i>	Still plentiful
Large white	<i>Pieris brassicae</i>	Far fewer than in the past
Orange-tip	<i>Anthocharis cardamines</i>	Two small colonies
Clouded yellow	<i>Colias croceus</i>	Migrant, seen most years sometimes in large numbers
Peacock	<i>Inachis io</i>	Can sometimes be seen throughout the year
Painted lady	<i>Vanessa cardui</i>	Breeds most years on thistles
Small tortoiseshell	<i>Maniola jurtina</i>	Plentiful late Summer nectaring on knapweed
Red admiral	<i>Vanessa atalanta</i>	Large numbers by Autumn on ivy blossom
Meadow brown	<i>Maniola jurtina</i>	Quite common
Ringlet	<i>Aphantopus hyperanthus</i>	Numbers vary a lot, but always some
Gate-keeper	<i>Pyronia tithonus</i>	Plentiful, most years
Small heath	<i>Coenonympha pamphilus</i>	Very few recently
Wall brown	<i>Lasiommata mergera</i>	Always in small numbers
Small copper	<i>Lycaena phlaeas</i>	At least two small colonies
Holly blue	<i>Celastrina argiolus</i>	Only present since 1998(more holly and ivy encouraged)
Small skipper	<i>Thymelicus icarus</i>	Plentiful
Large skipper	<i>Ochlodes venata</i>	Small numbers
Comma	<i>Polygonia c-album</i>	Seen most years recently
Dark-green fritillary	<i>Argynnis aglata</i>	First seen in 2014
Speckled wood	<i>Pararge aegeria</i>	Common
Monarch	<i>Danaus plexippus</i>	Seen high over buildings once in the 1990's
